## What is PRK?

PRK (Photorefractive Keratectomy) is a vision correction procedure that reshapes the cornea using a laser to improve the eye's ability to focus light. Unlike LASIK, PRK doesn't require the creation of a corneal flap. Instead, the outer layer of the cornea is gently removed, allowing the laser to reshape the tissue underneath.

The procedure is quick and effective, offering lasting results. It is particularly beneficial for individuals with thin corneas, as they may not be suitable candidates for LASIK due to the risk of complications related to corneal flaps.


## What to Expect During PRK Recovery

Recovery from PRK takes a bit longer than LASIK, but the outcome is well worth the wait.


After the procedure, a special bandage contact lens will be placed over the eye to protect it as the outer corneal layer (epithelium) heals. This lens helps minimize discomfort and supports the natural healing process.

You may experience mild discomfort, blurry vision, and sensitivity to light for a few days. These symptoms are normal and typically improve as the eye heals.


Most patients notice an improvement in vision within the first week, with full clarity developing over several weeks. It's important to follow your surgeon's aftercare instructions and attend all follow-up appointments to ensure a smooth recovery and optimal results.
